





From September 2 to 29, 2018, the FRAPRU will undertake a march from Ottawa to Québec City to defend the right to housing. More than 500 kms will be covered.

Currently, 305 590 households in Québec has a pressing need for housing. This goes to say that they have a unit that is too expensive for their means, too small for their families, and / or housing in bad condition. They are forced to live in a unit where they do not feel secure or that is not adapted to their physical needs.

To respond to the most pressing needs in a durable manner, it takes social housing now! The FRAPRU estimates that the need is 50 000 new social housing units in 5 years.

But the federal and provincial governments are dragging their feet. The investments by the federal and Québec governments finance no more than 3 000 new social housing units per year for all of Québec. It is takes eternity to construct because government subsidies are insufficient. In the last 5 years, only 9 953 social housing units were delivered. However, it is not money that is missing. In Québec only, the government had a surplus of 4,4 billion \$ during the 2017 fiscal year.

The FRAPRU march for the right to housing targets:

- Make visible the problems of those in bad housing conditions;
- Strengthen solidarity;

Put pressure on the governments in Ottawa & Québec to invest much more in social housing.
