244,120 tenant households are in core housing need. Meanwhile, the vacancy rate for rental housing has begun to drop dangerously in most cities in Quebec. If action isn't taken quickly, the poorest and most poorly housed may experience the consequences of a new housing shortage.

The FRAPRU calls on the Quebec government to invest in social housing. We've been wasting time for long enough! The AccèsLogis program - the only program that allows the development of social housing – hasn't been indexed in the last 10 years. As a result: there are now 12,500 promised social housing units that have yet to be built.

During the election campaign, François Legault's Coalition avenir Québec promised to deliver these homes during his first term. It is far from enough; the Legault government has the means to do much better! In 2017-2018, Québec had a budget surplus of \$2.6 billion; a further \$4.5 billion surplus is expected in 2018-19.

According to FRAPRU, a portion of these surpluses must be used to meet the needs of those who are worse-off.
