As part of its “For Social Housing Now!” campaign, FRAPRU is organizing caravans from different regions in Quebec. After visiting Legault government ministers, the caravans will converge in Quebec on Friday, February 7, 2020. The objective is to highlight the lack of social housing and to put pressure on the government to invest along these lines.

As proof: no fewer than 195, 636 tenant households pay more than 50% of their income to house themselves in Quebec and 40,000 tenant households are on the waiting list for an HLM, often for many years. In addition, the rental housing shortage affecting many regions is also aggravating the housing crisis they live with on a daily basis. To meet these urgent needs, and to do so sustainably, we must build social housing and do it quickly.

Last year, the Legault government only delivered 835 of the 3000 units of social housing that were promised. That’s not enough! In its March 2020 budget, it must make the necessary investments in AccèsLogis to build the thousands of social housing units that were announced 10 years ago, but have yet to be built due to lack of funding. It must also go further by building 50,000 social housing units in 5 years.

Contrary to its claims, Quebec doesn’t need to wait for federal assistance to begin taking on this challenge. It has accumulated billions of dollars in budget surpluses, and is depriving itself of significant revenue by refusing to make its fiscal policy more progressive. There are decisions that can be made in March 2020.
